Assessment for promoting better learning

- ✓ Assessment of student learning is not an end in itself. i.e assessment does not stop with evaluating students learning achievement and grading their performance based on the findings of assessment of student-learning.
- ✓ The teacher is required to provide students appropriate feedback enabling them to know the shortcomings in their learning and the means and methods of removing them
Because, teacher providing feedback to students is considered as an integral part of

Classroom teaching followed by assessment of student learning, teacher providing student's appropriate feedback based on the findings of the assessment.

Students taking efforts to remove the shortcomings in their learning based on the feedback they received, assessing the learning achievement of students again, after they refined it, further classroom instruction etc. form the cyclic activities in the teaching-learning process.


Based on the assessment of student learning..

those who are identified as significantly lagging behind others in their learning achievement should be subjected to a diagnostic test, conducted in the subject content taught and the teacher-is required to take up remedial measures based on the findings obtained from the diagnostic test

feedback that follows the assessment is an integral part of assessment; teaching and assessment are integrated together.
