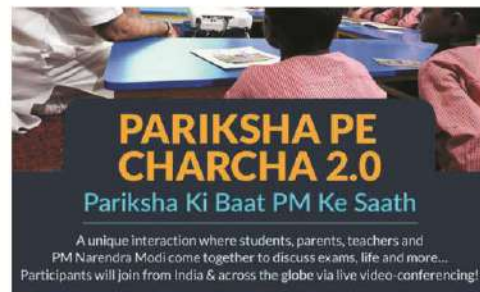
### Workshop on TLM
